

## MELBOURNE RACING CLUB – ACCREDITATION CONDITIONS

1. These accreditation conditions apply to all events held at a Melbourne Racing Club (MRC) venue. All accredited entrants to an event are required to comply with these accreditation conditions.
2. MRC may grant or reject the request for accreditation in its absolute discretion and accreditation may be subject to any further conditions as deemed necessary by MRC. Once granted, MRC may suspend or revoke accreditation at any time.
3. Any accreditation granted to an applicant is personal to that applicant. The rights in connection with accreditation may not be loaned, transferred or in any other way licensed or assigned to another person or entity for any purpose whatsoever without the prior written consent of MRC.
4. Accreditation access applies only to those specific areas within MRC venues that are necessary to perform activities directly relevant to the reason for accreditation.
5. Accreditation does not permit the holder to attend an event as a spectator, to occupy any seat, corporate or members' facility at an MRC venue that would normally be covered by a ticket or membership or to access a restricted area within the venue if the holder is not required in that area to perform their duties.
6. Accreditation must be worn and easily visible at all times, with photo identification clearly displayed, when performing duties or otherwise in restricted areas of an MRC venue.
7. Directions from MRC representatives and security staff must be adhered to at all times, including but not limited in relation to security requirements and the times and areas of access to the venues.
8. Accreditation passes remain the property of MRC and must be returned upon MRC's request.
9. Information provided in support of an accreditation application must be true and correct.
10. Accreditation applicants hereby consent to the collection, storage, use and disclosure of their personal information in accordance with MRC's Privacy Policy (<https://mrc.racing.com/our-club/governance/terms-and-conditions/privacy-policy>).
11. Accreditation access is subject to the satisfaction of any safety induction requirements, if requested by MRC
12. Entry to an event is subject to MRC's Conditions of Attendance (located at all venue entry points and posted on <https://mrc.racing.com/our-club/governance/terms-and-conditions/conditions-of-attendance>). Breach of MRC's Conditions of Attendance may result in removal from an event, confiscation of accreditation pass and/or withdrawal of accreditation privileges.
13. MRC may alter these terms and conditions at any time if such changes are reasonably necessary to address safety issues or otherwise protect the legitimate interests of MRC.
